ANTONI MIRALDA has created a three-dimensional work using drink cans, mounting them on top of each other to create the shape of a rocket.

In the same way that Andy Warhol gained inspiration from supermarket shelves and taking everyday objects such as detergents or Campbell's soup cans and turn them into works of art, the Catalan artist experiments with multi-coloured metallic containers and alludes to his ongoing theme of the culture of food.





How about reusing empty food containers (cartons, cardboard boxes, etc.) to make your own Pop Art sculpture (aesthetics of everyday life and consumer goods)?

You could wrap your containers in paper to make it easier to personalize your creation. You could also paste things to it such as pieces of fabric, textures, different types of paper, dot stickers, other stickers, etc.

In that way we give form and colour to the concept of reusing!



## **Materials:**

Any kind of used container that is easy to work with and assemble, all kinds of paper, pieces of cloth or rags, textures, coloured paints and glue.
