MAR ARZA made this diptych (set of two works) and in one of the pieces she has very meticulously extracted words from a cropped page from the book La ciudad de la ilusión.

She does it so carefully that the page has not been damaged and on the other page she has pasted the extracted words in such a way as to create a new script.

By means of this NON-WRITING the artist wants to show us that the simple act of undoing something or **distorting** some of its components generates **new stories**.

## **Materials:**

A piece of card or any kind of base upon which you can stick words that have been cut out of newspapers or magazines, scissors and a glue stick.

This technique is called collage and you can lay out your words in any shape, even in circles or spirals, etc.

Just let your imagination run wild!
